

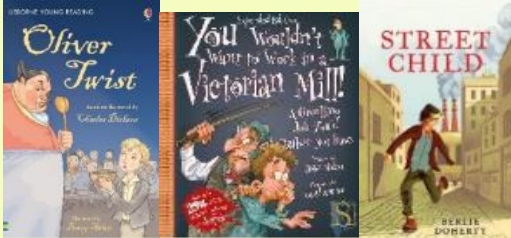


Year 5 Curriculum – Autumn 2

Writing- Purpose: We will be writing a setting description of a Victorian Workhouse and a recount of our theatre trip to see Oliver Twist.

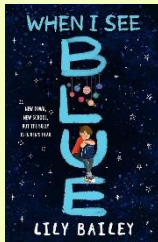
