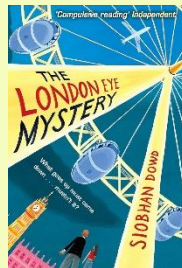
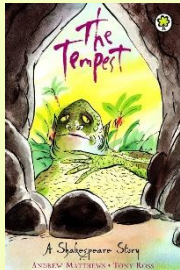


Grammar Coverage -

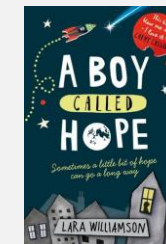
