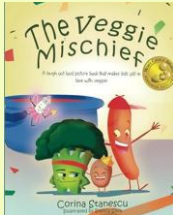

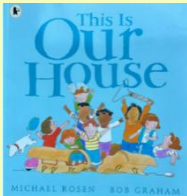

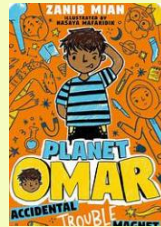

Maths



Place value: Numbers up to 100, be able to partition and use number lines. Flexible partitioning, finding 1, 10 or 100 more and less, counting in 50s.

Addition and Subtraction: Add/subtract 1s, 10s, 100s, add/subtract across 10s, 100s. Add/subtract two numbers with or without exchange, estimate answers, and use the inverse to check answers.

Writing (3 pieces)



Purpose: Writing to entertain and writing to inform

Grammar Coverage

Recap: Sentence construction, full stops and capital letters, commas in list, nouns, adjectives, verbs, noun phrases, apostrophes for possession, headings and subheadings, conjunctions.

Geography



Countries and Cities in the UK

Use compass reference points to locate cities in the UK on a map.

Identify and sort human and physical features.

Make comparisons using venn diagrams.

Skeletons, movement and nutrition

Identify and name human bones and the functions of the human skeleton.

Identify bones in animals.
